## Additional Workshops



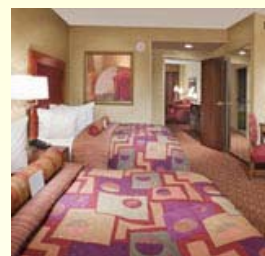
